## North Carolina Open Water Invitational And North Carolina Collegiate Challenge Sept. 8, 2012

<u>Location</u>: Seven Lakes NC (Directions: <u>www.sandshark.org</u>)

**Eligibility:** Swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming Inc.

**Awards:** Individual 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place will receive ribbons. Relays 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**Team Awards:** Top 3 for Men, Women, and Combined.

**Scoring:** Individual 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Scoring will be done in a separate computer system by FS Series; it will not be done

In Hy Tek, though all entries will be via Hy Tek.

**Entry Format:** Hy-Tek Team Manager. Swimmers may upload Hy-tek off Hy-Tek web site.

We strongly encourage submissions via Hy-Tek team manager.

**Entry Times:** Entry times can be entered but are not required.

**<u>Deadline and Fees:</u>** Entry forms (include a copy of USA registration if swimmer is not on a team

entry) are due to the meet director by <u>Tuesday Aug. 31st.</u> Each race is \$30.00. A \$40.00 late fee per swimmer (not per event) applies after the due date. On site

entries will be handled by FS Series and will include the late fee.

**Check-in:** All swimmers must be checked-in before the pre-race meeting. Check-in will

begin once the preceding race has started. In order to compete, **all forms** 

must be filled out, with signed release forms. GPS race chips, and race numbers will be issued to swimmers at check-in. Should the GPS system not be available, race numbers, written on swimmersqleft arms and shoulders, will be primary means of determining race finish order. A \$40 charge will be incurred for failure to return the

GPS chip.

Poseidon Awards Poseidon awards will be given to top 3 men/women for collegiate races and for age

group races to fastest combined 3K and 2K times. Age group Poseidon entrants must submit their names directly to SSS for manual entry into events outside of age

group.

**Pre-Race** Officials briefings will be held 45 minutes prior to each race for the meet director to

**Meeting:** review the course diagram with all the swimmers in that race. All swimmers

should attend. Note: Athletes straying from the course will only be

corrected when out of bounds.

Race 30 minutes prior to each race, the announcer will count-down the start of the

<u>Countdown:</u> race in 5-minute intervals. 20 minutes before each race, a GPS check in will be conducted to ensure that all swimmers are recorded entering the water, in

accordance with USA Open Water Swimming Safety guidelines. Any swimmer

missing this check in will be disqualified. 1-minute intervals will be announced for the last 5 minutes until the start of the race.

Start: The start will begin in the water. All races will be swum counter-clockwise. Waves

may be done at the discretion of the Meet Director.

Swimmers must enter the water by walking over the pads to register their chips

during the GPS check in 20 minutes prior to race time.

There will be 1 shoot with 3 pads under the Finish Tent. The GPS chips will Finish:

**Team Pursuit Relays:** Each Collegiate team can enter 2 Mixes Pursuit Relays for the 2k Team Time Trial.

One relay must be 2 male and 1 female; one must be 2 female and 1 male.

Relays will start at 1 minute intervals. Team time will be based on last swimmer to finish. All swimmers must follow team pursuit rules in accordance with 5K guidelines

in FINA BL 9.3.7.5:

5 km Team Event as Time Trial

A team shall consist of three (3) swimmers, either one (1) man and two (2) women or two

(2) men and one(1) woman.

Every team shall start with all swimmers together sixty (60) seconds after the preceding

team.

 The allocation of starting positions shall be taken from automatic random draw. The ranking shall be decided by the individual time achieved by the third swimmer of the team.

**Protests:** Must be filed in writing on the designated form with the Clerk of Course within 45

minutes from the time unofficial results are posted.

Paddlers and escort boats will be spaced throughout the course to provide help to **Escorts:** 

swimmers as needed. If a swimmer touches an escort craft, he/she must withdraw

from the race.

**Race Committee:** Will consist of the Meet Referee, Site Director, and three coaches appointed by the

Meet Referee.

### **Events**

# 15 & Over, 13/14, Open 3K:

This race will be 3 loops around a 1K loop of the designated course. The race will end in 60 minutes. All swimmers who have not completed the course will be asked to retire. Positive check-in will begin at 2:30 pm. There will be a pre-race meeting at 3:00pm. **Event will begin at 3:30pm.** 

### 11/12 and Open 2K:

This race will be 2 loops around a 1K loop of the designated course. The race will end in 60 minutes. All swimmers who have not completed the course will be asked to retire. Positive check-in will begin at 3:30 pm. Pre-race meeting will begin at 4:00 pm. **Event will begin at 4:30 pm.** 

### **Collegiate Team Pursuit:**

This race will be 2 loops around the 1K loop of the designated course. The race will end in 60 minutes. All swimmers who have not completed the course will be asked to retire. Positive check-in will begin at 5:00. Prerace meeting will begin at 5:10. **Event will begin at 5:30.** 

All races will be seeded as a single event, without regard to swimmer's age or gender. Places, awards, and published results for these events will be separated for each event, age group and gender. Meet Director reserves the right to change seeding if a large number of entries warrant changes.
