SANCTION: Held under the sanction of USA Swimming, Inc., issued by North

Carolina Swimming, Inc. Sanction #NC12099

LOCATION: Taishoff Aquatic Pavilion, located in the Wilson Recreation Center on

Duke University west Campus.

FACILITY: The facility boasts a 25-yard, eight-lane racing pool with seven-foot

lanes and a depth tapering from 4½ feet at each end to a depth of 7 feet in the center. Other features include custom built stainless starting blocks and ample spectator seating. An eight-lane Omega electronic timing system with a full eight-lane display board will be used. In addition, a warm-up/warm-down diving well, adjacent to the competition pool, will be available for continuous warm-up/warm-down. Spectator seating is available. The competition pool has not been certified in

accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

FACILITY RULES: *Swimmers and spectators should enter thru the back lobby and must

remain out of the exercise and recreation area.

*No smoking is allowed inside the facility. *Please observe all posted facility rules.

*All persons on-deck or behind the blocks must be certified coaches,

officials, registered swimmers or meet volunteers.

CLASSIFICATION: This is a 13 & over meet open to all swimmers.

SCHEDULE: General warm-ups: 7:30 . 8:25 am.

Timed Finals will begin at 8:30 pm.

ELIGIBILITY: All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and be

members of Duke Aquatics or Greenville Swim Club.

ENTRIES: Swimmers are limited to FIVE total events, with a maximum of FOUR

individual events. Teams are limited to a maximum of TWELVE entries in events 100 & shorter, EIGHT entries in 200 events, and FOUR entries in events 400 and over. Duke Aquaticsqswimmers will be seeded in odd lanes, GSC swimmers will be seeded in even lanes.

ENTRY DEADLINE: A Hy-Tek Meet Manager compatible entry file should be submitted to

the meet director no later than Friday, October 13, 2012.

ENTRY FEES: \$18 per swimmer, which includes the NC Travel surcharge. Checks

should be made payable to Duke Aquatics.q

> USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches and officials to show proof of certification/registration. Coaches and officials shall

prominently display their registration cards while on deck.

SAFETY: The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are

advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. No running or

horseplay will be tolerated.

RACING STARTS: Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA swimming

> member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmers

legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RULES: The meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA

> Swimming Rules and Regulations and the NCS Safety Program, except where rules therein are optional an exceptions are herein granted.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not

permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

DISABILITY Duke Aquatics welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in STATEMENT: the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in

our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the meet director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit

Duke Aquatics ability to accommodate all requests.
