SAFETY

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be tolerated. Add any additional facility rules here also.

RACING STARTS

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by an USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by an USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RULES

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated. If following the NCS Scratch Rule: The NCS Scratch Rule is in effect for this meet. Include the scratch rule (on separate page) and any penalties that may be accessed.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

ELIGIBILITY

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on deck registration available at this meet. Include any minimum/maximum time standards for qualification to enter the event, team affiliations, etc.

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES

NOMAD AQUATICS welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit NOMAD'S ability to accommodate all requests.

ENTRIES

Entries submitted in Hy-tek format require no hard copy entry forms. Email is preferred for electronic entries however, disks are also acceptable. Payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by the entry deadline. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. NOMAD entries will be entered first and then accept teams/entries in the order received, until the four/eight hour rule is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately. All relay only swimmers including alternates must be listed and pay the NCS Travel Fund surcharge.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

12 and under swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events plus 2 relays per day(timed finals) and 13 and over may swim total of 3 individual events(prelims and finals) and 2 relays(timed finals) for the meet.

ENTRY VERIFICATION

An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

ENTRY DEADLINES

The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by TUES.27TH BY 6:00PM

(note: no earlier than 10 days prior to the start date of the meet). Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

SEEDING

The conforming time standard for this meet is short/long course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order

CHECK-IN

A positive check-in, located on pool deck by the starter, will be required for the following events:

1000/1650 free

Check in for event will be $\frac{1}{2}$ hour prior to session start to scratch, seed, and produce meet programs. Swimmers that fail to check in will be scratched from the event and not seeded.

In the positive check-in events, a swimmer who has checked in, been seeded, and fails to complete in said event, shall be barred from his/her next individual event. If no penalty is stated, no penalty may be accessed.

SCRATCHES

There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block. If following the NCS Scratch Rule: The NCS Scratch Rule is in effect for this meet. Include the scratch rule (on a separate page) and any penalties that may be accessed.

SCORING

List points and places that will score, if applicable. If not, state: No team or individual scoring will be kept. For example: All scoring will be on a sixteen (16) place basis.

- Individual events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-
- Relay events: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2; only 2 relays per gender may score for each team.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the top 3 individual finishers in each age group, 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, and 13-14 and Seniors. Ribbons for 4^{th} - 8^{th} individual events. Ribbons for 1^{st} – 3^{rd} place in relays.

Hi-point trophies for top 3 finishers in each age group.

RESULTS

Results will be posted on NOMAD'S website within 24 hours of the meets conclusion. At the conclusion of the meet, teams may obtain Hy-tek backups either on a memory stick or via email attachment.

COACHES

All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of certification/registration and shall prominently display their registration cards at all times while on deck. There will be a coach/general meeting 3:45 IN THE HOSPITALITY ROOM. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches meetings.

OFFICIALS/TIMERS/VOLUNTEERS

There will be a need for officials. NOMAD welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet or sign in once you arrive at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of certification/registration. Officials shall prominently display their registration cards at all times while on deck. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers. Official briefings will be held one hour prior to the start of each session in the hospitality area.

HOSPITALITY/CONCESSIONS

There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials. Some refreshments may be bought in the pro-shop are as well.

WARM-UP

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.
