FACILITY

The Greensboro Aquatic Center is a state-of-the-art indoor facility with three pools which opened in August 2011. The main competition pool is 9-10 feet deep at both ends and will be configured into one 50 meter yard course with eight 9-foot wide lanes each. All lanes feature non-turbulent lane lines and Colorado starting blocks. Up to eight lanes will be used for this competition. The Colorado electronic timing system will be used. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming. At least three lanes will be open for continuous warm up and down. Seating for 1800 spectators is available. The Greensboro Coliseum will provide free parking. Directions to the GAC are available at www.GreensboroAquaticCenter.com.

MEET FORMAT

This is a closed time trial pre-seeded meet unless otherwise indicated.

ELIGIBILITY

These NCAA **DIII, DII & DI** LC Time Trials are open to any member of an NCAA DIII Men's or Women's Swimming team who is eligible to represent his/her school in NCAA competition in the 2015-2016 season, and to any member of an NCAA DII or DI Men's or Women's Swimming team from North or South Carolina who is eligible to represent his/her school in NCAA competition in the 2015-2016 season.

The results of these LC Time Trials will NOT be uploaded to the NCAA database and will NOT be considered for NCAA Championship meet qualification.

Swimmers who are also 2016 registered members of USA Swimming and are registered through their respective LSCs prior to March 14th will have their

results automatically uploaded to SWIMS for USA Swimming meet qualification. No on deck registration is available.

RULES

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated.

ENTRIES Entry files may be emailed to the Entry Coordinator until the stated deadlines.

On deck entries will be accepted during regular TT sign up hours at Championship meet.

Entries should be made with LCM or SCY times. Times are not required to be provable and may be estimated to provide accurate seeding for all competitors. NT entries will be seeded last.

ENTRY DEADLINES

Entries may be submitted via Hytek email up until midnight on Tuesday, Mar. 15.

On deck entries submitted on Sunday Mar. 20th will be considered late and accepted only for open lanes and at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS Swimmers may swim a maximum of three (3) time trials. Breaks may be scheduled by the Meet Referee and will be announced in the coaches' meetings.

ENTRY FEES No fees will be charged.

CHECK-IN

A positive check-in, located at clerk of course, will be required for the following events:

- 800M Freestyle
- 1500M Freestyle

Swimmers should positively check in for their events by 9:00 AM to be seeded.

SEEDING

The conforming time standard for this meet is long course meters. Swimmers will be seeded slowest to fastest, LCM then SCY. The Meet Referee reserves the right to combine heats and events according to USA Swimming rules.

WARM-UP

General warm up in all lanes from 8:00-9:00 AM. Specific warm ups from 9:00-9:20 as follows: one-way dive starts in Lanes 2 and 7, pace in Lanes 1 and 8, general warm up in other lanes. Additional sprint and pace lanes may be assigned at the Meet Referee's discretion. The Marshal will ensure teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures.

During the competition, there will be at least three lanes available for continuous warm-up/down. Swimmers will enter the pool feet first in this area.

SAFE SPORT

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions in addition to host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

DECK CHANGES ARE PROHIBITED.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

SCORING/AWARDS

This session will not be scored and no awards will be made.

RESULTS

Results will be posted on GAC's website (<u>www.GreensboroAquaticCenter.com</u>) within 24 hours of each meet's conclusion and teams will be emailed their results.

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES

Queens University welcomes all NCAA swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in the meet. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit Queens University's ability to accommodate all requests.

COACHES

All coaches on deck must be registered and properly certified with their NCAA teams and must check in with the Meet Director.

There may be a General Meeting at 9:20 AM at the Meet Referee's discretion. Other meetings may be held at the Meet Referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings. Coaches are responsible for any information presented at the meeting.

OFFICIALS

Queens University welcomes and encourages USA Swimming certified officials to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of current certification/registration to the meet referee. Officials briefings will be held 60 minutes prior to the start of the session in the hospitality area.

Uniform for this meet is white polo over navy pants, shorts, or skirts with white shoes.

HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS

There will be limited hospitality available on deck to all coaches and officials. Refreshments will be for sale at concession stands. Outside food beyond that needed for swimmer nutrition and hydration is not permitted by the facility.
