**FACILITY**

The Queens Levine pool is a 33 1/3 meter x 20 yard 8 lane Paddock Pool racing tank. The pool depth ranges from 10 feet at the starting end to 5 feet at the far end of the pool with eight lanes with non-turbulent lane lines. Paddock starting blocks will be used for competition in accordance with the USA Swimming diving depth guidelines. The facility also features a Colorado 5000 timing system and an eight lane scoreboard. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used. The pool also has 1 bulkheads for 4 lanes of 20 yards for warmup and cooldown. The diving side of the pool, the 25 yard pool has a pool depth of 10 feet at the start end to 9.5 feet on the turn end. Spectator bleacher seating is available. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USASwimming.

**TIME TRIALS**

At the discretion of the Meet Referee, Time Trials may be offered at the conclusion of the session. Swimmers requesting a time trial need to be entered in at least one event in the meet in order to swim a time trial. Time trials are \$5.00 per swim. Swimmers are limited to 1 time trial swim for the meet. Time trials will count against the swimmer's daily event limit and the event total for athletes entered in the meet. Swimmers must notify the Meet Referee before the completion of their last event if they would like to swim a time trial. Time trial swimmers must provide their own timer. All USA Swimming Rules will apply to Time Trials.

**SAFETY**

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be tolerated.

**RACING STARTS**

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by an USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by an USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**RULES**

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated. The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changes are prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Vice President of Program Operations.

**ELIGIBILITY**

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and members of SwimMAC or Queens University. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on deck registration available at this meet. This is a by invitation meet.

**SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES**

SwimMAC Carolina welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit Queen's ability to accommodate all requests.

**ENTRIES** Entries submitted in Hy-tek format are required; no hard copy entry forms. Email is preferred for electronic entries however, disks are also acceptable. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. Entries will be received until the four hour rule is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately.

**ENTRY LIMITATIONS** Swimmers may participate in a maximum of 3 individual events for the day.

**ENTRY VERIFICATION** An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

**ENTRY DEADLINES** The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

**SEEDING** The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order.

**SCRATCHES** There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block.

**RESULTS** Results will be emailed to coaches within 24 hours of the meets conclusion.

**COACHES** All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. A general meeting may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Coaches are accountable for the information presented.

**OFFICIALS/TIMERS/  
VOLUNTEERS**

There will be a need for officials. SwimMAC welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet or sign in once you arrive at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of such to the meet referee by displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. A certification card showing the official's level of certification must also be presented. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers. Official briefings will be held in the hospitality area at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary.

**HOSPITALITY/  
CONCESSIONS**

There will not be a hospitality provide. Water will be available from coolers on deck.

**WARM-UP**

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshal will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.

**As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet.
