FACILITY

This pool is an 8 lane 50 meter pool with non-turbulent lane lines and Paragon starting blocks. Lane width is 9 ft. Colorado electronic timing system with an 8 lane scoreboard will be used. Pool depth ranges from 7-12 ft., with starting blocks at both ends. Smoking is not permitted inside the building. The facility has seating to accommodate 1000 spectators. There is ample parking within 100 yards of the facility. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

CLASSIFICATION

Invitational

INVITED TEAMS

Sailfish Aquatics, Mecklenburg Swim Association, Team Charlotte, Queen City Dolphins New South Swimming, and Star Aquatics. Entries from these teams could be restricted if the number of entries are too large. Other teams may be invited if there is available space.

MEET FORMAT

There will be multiple sessions in the meet, including 10 & Under Timed Finals and 11-12, 13-14 and 15&over Prelim/Finals. Saturday and Sunday's 11-12, 13-14, and 15 & over events will be swum as prelims in the morning and finals in the evening. All 13-14 and 15&over events will be combined during Saturday and Sunday prelims. The event finals will be separated out into the appropriate age group and gender. There will be a consolation (B) heat and a championship (A) heat swum in all events with the consolation(B) heat swimming first.

Meet Management reserves the right to modify/add or change sessions as needed due to the number of entries.

Friday will be a timed finals session. Saturday and Sunday Evening Finals will be as follows:

- 11-12 year olds will have one (1) heat of finals for each event.
- 13-14 year old 200, 100 and 50 Events will have two (2) heats of finals (B and A in that order).
- 15& over events will have two (2) heats of finals (B and A in that order).

SAFETY

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be tolerated.

RACING STARTS

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by an USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by an USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RULES

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

ELIGIBILITY

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. to participate. Swimmers without current proof of membership will not swim. **THERE WILL BE NO ON DECK REGISTRATION.**

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES

Sailfish Aquatics welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit Sailfish Aquatics' ability to accommodate all requests.

ENTRIES

Please email entries using Hy-Tek Team Manager for entries. List all swimmers' ages as of **July 27, 2018**. Entries may be sent via email and must include the following:

1. A Hy-Tek compatible entry file
2. Team entry report
3. Financial report
4. List of all coaches who will be in attendance to confirm current credentials.

A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

11 & Over swimmers are limited to a maximum of 3 individual events per day and 8 individual events throughout the weekend.

10 & Under swimmers are limited to a maximum of 4 individual events per day and 10 individual events throughout the weekend.

Required provable entry time for these 10&Under events:

200 Free, girls 4:00.00. Boys 3:45.00

200 IM, girls 4:00.00. Boys 4:00.00

400 Free, 400 IM, 800 Free - 12 and unders must have BB time and NT(no time) are not accepted.

Relays are not included in the entry limit. Meet Management reserves the right to limit and/or eliminate events to allow the meet to run in the allotted time.

ENTRY VERIFICATION An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

ENTRY DEADLINES The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries **10:00 pm Tuesday, July 17, 2018**. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee. There may be on-deck entries but only in open lanes and at the discretion of the meet director. **Double fees will apply to all late entries and must be paid before entry can be done on deck.**

SEEDING The conforming time standard for this meet is long course meters. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order. There will be no course conversion for this meet. The 400 IM, 400 Free and 800 Free will be deck seeded slowest to fastest. No Time will not be accepted for entries in these events, entries may be limited to stay within the allotted time.

CHECK-IN A positive check-in, located at clerk of course, will be required for the following events:

- 400 IM
- 800 Free
- 400 Free

Check in for events will be as stated in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Swimmers that fail to check in will be scratched from the event and not seeded. In the positive check-in events, a swimmer who has checked in, been seeded, and fails to complete in said event, shall be barred from his/her next individual event. Swimmers will have to provide their own lap counters. Swimmers may have to provide their own timers.

SCRATCHES	A modified scratch rule will be used. Swimmers in announced A or B finals, must either scratch or declare their intent to scratch within 30 minutes of announcement. If a swimmer declares intent and does not return to scratch, they will be seeded in the final event. A swimmer who then fails to compete in said final, shall be barred from his/her next individual event. The Meet Referee may waive this penalty at their discretion for medical or unpreventable circumstances. Swimmers are requested to scratch their events regardless of place if they are not returning for Sunday Finals.
SCORING	There will be no scoring for this meet.
AWARDS	Individual Events : 1 st – 3 rd place medals, 4 th – 8 th place ribbons -Relays: 1 st – 3 rd place ribbons
RESULTS	Live results will be posted on Sailfish Aquatics’ website and will be available on Meet Mobile. At the conclusion of the meet results will be sent to each team via email attachment.
COACHES	All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee’s discretion. Meet Management requires that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches meetings. Teams that do not attend accept responsibility for any changes or alterations to the meet information.
OFFICIALS/TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS	There will be a need for officials. Sailfish Aquatics welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet or sign in once you arrive at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of such to the meet referee by displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. A certification card showing the official’s level of certification must also be presented. Any official’s assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers. Official briefings will be held in the hospitality area at the date and time listed in the Meet Schedule and Deadlines table.
HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS	There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials. Refreshments will be available at the concession stand.

WARM-UP

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down in the adjacent warm pool as allowed by the facility.

There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.

WAIVER/RELEASE

As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet. Sailfish Aquatics, Mecklenburg County Aquatics Center, North Carolina Swimming, Inc., and USA Swimming, Inc., their agents, employees, and coaches shall be held free and harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of illness or injury to anyone during the conduct of this meet. You acknowledge that by entering this meet, you are granting permission for the names of any or all of your team's swimmers to be published on the internet in the form of Psych Sheets, Meet Results, or any other documents associated with the running of this meet.
