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## **FACILITY**

HFFA is a 12,952 square foot pool area featuring a 50 meter by 25 yard Paddock Pool racing tank. The pool depth ranges from 6 feet at the starting end to 17 feet at the far end (diving) of the pool with eight, 9 foot wide lanes with non-turbulent lane lines. Paragon starting blocks will be used for competition in accordance with the USA Swimming diving depth guidelines. The facility also features a Colorado 5000 timing system and an eight lane scoreboard. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used. The pool also has 2 bulkheads for 2-25 yard pools with 8 lanes each. In the 25 yard competition pool, using the scoreboard end of the pool, the pool depth ranges from 6 feet at the start end to 6 feet 9 inches at the turn end. The diving side of the pool, the 25 yard pool has a pool depth of 7 feet at the start end to 17 feet on the turn end. There will be a continuous warm up and warm down lanes available between the bulkheads. Spectator bleacher seating is available. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

### **SAFETY**

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be tolerated.

### **RACING STARTS**

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by an USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by an USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

# **RULES**

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated. The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changes are prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on deck registration available at this meet.

# SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES

SwimMAC welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit SwimMAC's ability to accommodate all requests.

## **ENTRIES**

Entries submitted in Hy-tek format require no hard copy entry forms. Email is preferred for electronic entries however, disks are also acceptable. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. Entries will be received until the four hour rule is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately.

### **ENTRY LIMITATIONS**

Swimmers may participate in a maximum of 4 individual events for the day. 12 & under swimmers may swim in only one session but not both.

### **ENTRY VERIFICATION**

An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

## **ENTRY DEADLINES**

The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary.

**SEEDING** The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers

will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated.

All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order.

**COACHES** All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming.

Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. A general meeting may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Coaches are accountable for the

information presented.

OFFICIALS/TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS There will be a need for officials. SwimMAC welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet or sign in once you arrive at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of such to the meet referee by displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. A certification card showing the official's level of certification must also be presented. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers. Official briefings will be held in the hospitality area at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary.

HOSPITALITY/
CONCESSIONS

There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials.

Refreshments will be available at the concession stand.

WARM-UP In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published

warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). There is to be no diving

or horseplay in this area.
