#### **RMY COVID-19 MEET PLAN**

#### NCS FACE COVERING STATEMENT

Following new CDC recommendations and the North Carolina Governor's latest Executive Order issued May 14, 2021, North Carolina Swimming has revised guidance on the use of face coverings at USA Swimming activities as follows:

- North Carolina Swimming strongly recommends that partially vaccinated or unvaccinated individuals continue to wear face coverings and practice social distancing at all swimming activities.
- Other individuals are welcome to continue wearing face coverings for personal comfort.
- NCS clubs may require that participants wear face coverings and observe social distancing at meets that they host.
- NCS members are expected to comply with all COVID-19 safety guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, the State of North Carolina, local jurisdictions, aquatic facilities, and member clubs.

#### FACILITY and HOST TEAM REQUIREMENTS

RMY has discussed specific health and safety procedures with the venue management. At this time, the facility and HOST TEAM have no additional requirements. Compliance with the most current guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, CDC, State and Local jurisdictions will be maintained throughout the duration of the meet.

## SPECTATOR LIMITATIONS and PROTOCOLS

There will be in person spectator viewing. Spectators will use restrooms in the lobby area adjacent to the pool or the "Men's" and "Women's" locker rooms. "Boy's" and "Girl's" locker rooms are strictly for use by athletes.

#### **FACILITY**

Pool: 25 yard, 8 lanes with non-turbulent lane ropes. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Each lane is 7 feet wide. Depth at start end of pool is 9 feet, and 4 feet deep at the turn end with Spectrum Xcellerator starting blocks, Daktronics electronic timing system with 8 lane scoreboard. Timing system will include touch pads and two timers per lane, each operating both a button and a watch. Deck changing is prohibited in the facility.

#### **RULES**

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated.

## TECHNICAL SUIT BAN for 12&Us

Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete inTechnical Suits at this meet.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric orsilhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type

#### **MAAPP**

All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge thatthey are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

#### **SAFE SPORT**

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowedinside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted inchanging areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race. Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member- coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by amember-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and be members of USA Swimming. All Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on deck registration available at this meet.

# MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS

RMY welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit RMY's ability to accommodate all requests.

#### **ENTRIES**

All entries will be submitted in Hy-Tek format. A completed and signed Entry Summary Sheet (included in the announcement) and payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by the entry deadline unless approved by meet host-i.e. check will be brought presented to the meet director prior to competing. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for theentire meet. RMY entries will be entered first and then accept teams/entries in the order received, until the four/eight-hour rule is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately. All relay only swimmersincluding alternates must be listed and pay the NCS Travel Fund surcharge.

**ENTRY LIMITATIONS** 

Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events plus 1 relay per day and atotal of 8 individual events and 2 relays for the meet.

**ENTRY VERIFICATION** 

An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of their entry within 24 hours of receipt.

**ENTRY DEADLINES** 

The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by Wednesday, December 29, 2021. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

**SEEDING** The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers will be seeded

and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated

**CHECK-IN** All events will be pre-seeded, there will be no positive check-ins.

**SCRATCHES** There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block.

**SCORING** No team or individual scoring will be kept.

**AWARDS** Ribbons will be awarded to the top 8 finishers in each individual events and the top 3 finishers

in relays.

**RESULTS** A TM results file will be sent to participating teams within 24 hours of the meets conclusion via

email.

**COACHES**All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management

will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. There will be a coach/general meeting at the dateand time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at

least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.

OFFICIALS/TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS There will be a need for officials. **RMY** welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer. Volunteering Officials **MUST** contact the Meet Referee by email <u>prior to the meet.</u> All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Certification will be verified by Meet Referee the day before the meet/session. There will be no officials meeting at the meet,

and assignments will be communicated electronically prior to each session. A virtual meeting may be held prior to the meet/session at the referee's discretion, and all assigned officials are strongly encouraged to complete an individual personal review of applicable USAS rules for their assigned position prior to the meet. Officials should report to their assigned position 10 minutes before session start and bring a mask, your personal water bottle, a writing utensil, and a headset (if applicable).

### HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS

There will be limited hospitality open to all coaches and officials. Refreshments willbe available at the concession stand.

**WARM-UP** 

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.

WAIVER/RELEASE

As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet. RMY and the Harrison Family YMCA, North Carolina Swimming, Inc., and USA Swimming, Inc., their agents, employees, and coaches shall be held free and harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of illness or injury to anyone during the conduct of this meet. You acknowledge that by entering this meet, you are granting permission forthe names of any or all of your team's swimmers to be published on the internet in the form of Psych Sheets, Meet Results, or any other documents associated with the running of this meet.

**IMAGE RELEASE** 

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the host club approved photographer(s) and videographers and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the host club or NCS website or social media or inpublic broadcast of the event via television or webcast. Parents and guardians of minor swimmers who do not wish their swimmers to participate in interviews or have individual pictures featured on any media should inform their team's head coach and the Meet Director prior to the meet.
