 REQUIREMENTS
 North Carolina Swimming, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), state and local jurisdictions will be maintained throughout the duration of the meet. At the time of sanction Guilford County and the Greensboro Aquatic Center have no mask mandates. The Greensboro Aquatic Center strongly encourages individuals who are not fully vaccinated to maintain distance whenever possible.

- ENTRY & EXIT Swimmers, coaches, and volunteers will be allowed in the building no more than fifteen (15) minutes prior to warm-ups. All athletes, coaches, and volunteers will enter and exit the facility through the designated entrance. Athletes will access the deck through the locker rooms. Coaches and volunteers will access the deck through the hospitality area or the cut-through hallway. When entering the facility, all athletes and coaches will proceed to their designated seating area. Volunteers should check in and proceed to their assigned area.
- ATHLETETeams will be assigned seating on deck. Athletes must remain seated in theirSEATING AREASteam area when not traveling to or from warm-up lanes or race-ready. No
outside chairs are allowed in the facility.
- SPECTATORSpectators will be allowed in the building no more than fifteen (15) minutes prior
to warm-ups. There is a spectator seating area with a capacity of 1850 persons.
The spectator seating area will not be specifically assigned or marked for this
meet. No outside chairs are allowed in the facility. Spectators are not allowed
on the pool deck at any time.
- PARENTALParents needing access to their athletes during the meet in a closed-deckACCESSenvironment can contact their children directly via cellphone and arrange to meet
them in the concourse. Should parents be unable to contact their children
directly, they should call or text their coach. In the case of an emergency, please
call and/or text the Meet Director(s) at the numbers on the first page of this meet
announcement.
- **FACILITY** The Greensboro Aquatics Center is a 50-meter pool which can be broken into two short course venues with a separate diving well. This competition will use the

long course competition venue that is 8 lanes with continuous warm-up and cooldown lanes available throughout the meet in the short course dive well. The pool depth is 9'-10' at the start and turn ends and 4" lane lines will be used to reduce turbulence. The lane width is 7'. An Omega timing system with a Daktronics Pro-Star LED Video Scoreboard Display will display results simultaneously. Starting platforms are Omega deck anchored platforms. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Only athletes, officials, coaches, and meet volunteers may be on deck during warm-ups and/or competition. <u>The 650 bleacher seats on deck are reserved for swimmers only</u>. **No outside chairs are permitted in the stands or on deck**.

Locker rooms are reserved for athlete use. Separate rest room facilities are available or officials, coaches, and volunteers.

- **VENUE SHOPS** Augusta Swim Supply will be open in the Greensboro Aquatic Center during the meet. Food and drink may be purchased from the concession stand located in the facility. **No outside food or drink will be permitted.**
- **PARKING** Parking will be \$5.00 per day with re-entry allowed. Parking for coaches and officials will be provided.
- **MEET FORMAT**This is a Long Course Age Group/Senior open meet consisting of six timed final
sessions, including an open timed final session on Friday. All events will be pre-
seeded unless otherwise indicated.

SAFE SPORT The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be tolerated.

Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas.

Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms.

No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time.

Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate.

Use of audio or visual recording or photography devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming membercoach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time. All persons on deck or behind the blocks must be USAS certified coaches, officials, registered swimmers, or meet volunteers.

TECHNICAL SUITPer USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete inBAN for 12&UsTechnical Suits at this meet.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or midthigh regardless of the seam type.
- **RULES** This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated.
- **ELIGIBILITY** All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc., and all adult athletes must hold current APT certifications to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. **THERE WILL BE NO ON DECK REGISTRATION AVAILABLE AT THIS MEET.**

There are no qualifying time standards for this meet.

If a swimmer has not competed in an event as LCM this season, it is recommended to use short course yards (SCY) times for more accurate seeding. All entries in SCY will be converted to LCM. List all swimmers' ages as of June 2, 2023.

RESULTS	Results will be posted to Meet Mobile and to the STAR webpage as available. At the conclusion of the meet, results will be sent to each team via email attachment.
COACHES	All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or showing their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Meet Schedule and Deadlines table. Other meetings may be held at the Meet Referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.
OFFICIALS/ TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS	All teams may be required to provide timers based on the number of swimmers entered in the meet. Timer assignments will be distributed after registration has closed.
	There will be a need for officials. Star Aquatics welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet, sign up using the link on the meet page on the STAR Aquatics website (<i>www.staraquatics.net</i>), or sign in once you arrive at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be

required to show proof of such to the Meet Referee by displaying their registration card or showing their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. A certification card showing the official's level of certification must also be presented. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers. Official briefings will be held in the hospitality area at the date and time listed in the Meet Schedule and Deadlines table.

- **HOSPITALITY** There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials.
- WARM-UP In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warmup procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshal will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/cool-down. There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area. Only feet-first entry into the warm-up lanes is permitted.
- WAIVER/ As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all the RELEASE swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet. NCS Scratch Rule

208.3. INDIVIDUAL SCRATCH RULE Swimmers shall inform themselves of the meet starting time and shall report to the proper meet authorities promptly upon call. The meet announcement shall specify all mandatory check-in and scratch deadlines and procedures.

- .1 Pre-Seeded Meets Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event shall not be penalized.
- .2 Events Seeded on the Deck Any swimmer entered in an individual event that is seeded on the deck, in whole or in part, who has checked in for that event, must swim in the event unless the swimmer notifies the clerk of course before the seeding for that event has begun that the swimmer wishes to scratch or as noted in 208.3.4 A or D. Failure to scratch prior to seeding and not swimming the event will result in the swimmer being barred from the next individual event in which the swimmer entered in the meet. Unless the meet announcement states otherwise, events seeded on the deck shall be closed for seeding no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the event except that individual events of 400 meters or longer may be closed for seeding up to twenty-four (24) hours before the expected start of the event if the check-in/scratch deadline occurs after the beginning of the meet and is announced in the meet announcement.
- .3 Preliminary and Finals Events
 - A. Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in a pre-seeded preliminary heat when finals are scheduled shall not be penalized. If the preliminary heat is seeded on the deck then 208.3.2 applies
 - B. Any swimmer qualifying for an A final, scored or not scored, or B scored final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said A or B final race shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet, except as noted in 208.3.4. A declared false start or deliberate delay of meet is not permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete.
 - C. In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from competition, when possible, the Referee shall fill the A, B, or C final with the next qualified swimmer(s). First and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These and all other alternates and those qualifying for non-scoring B or C finals shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete
 - D. When the B or C final has not yet been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known in advance by the Referee, the Referee should re-seed the A, B, or C finals, if necessary, to insert the alternate(s) in the appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in the final. In order to prevent undue delay of the A, B, or C finals, the Referee may elect to fill the empty lane(s), without reseeding, with the next qualified alternate, or if unavailable, the next qualified swimmer(s) who is/are present in the starting area and ready to swim
 - E. If a C or B final has already been swum, the A final of that event shall be swum without filling the empty lane(s)
- .4 Exception for Failure to Compete No penalty shall apply for failure to compete in or scratch an individual event if:
 - A. The Referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof.
 - B. The swimmers qualifying for an A final or B final race based upon the results of the preliminaries notifies the Referee within thirty (30) minutes after announcement of the qualifiers of that final race that they may not intend to compete and also declares his final decision whether or not to scratch within thirty (30) minutes following his last individual preliminary heat, swim-off, or re-swim.

- C. The swimmer was not named in any finals heat during the initial announcement of results
- D. It is determined by the Referee that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

208.4. RELAY SCRATCH RULE

.1 All Meets - Any relay or relay member, in a relay event that fails to compete in or report for that event shall not be penalized.
