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FACILITY and PACPAC has discussed specific health and safety procedures with the venue management.REQUIREMENTSAt this time, the facility and PAC have no additional requirements. Compliance with
the most current guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, CDC, State
and Local jurisdictions will be maintained throughout the duration of the meet.

FACILITYThe Edward M. Armfield Civic Center has an eight-lane 25-yard indoor pool with
7ft. wide non-turbulent lanes, a Daktronics timing system complete with eight lane
scoreboard and touch pads. The automatic timing system uses touch pads and one
timer per lane, each operating a button and a stopwatch. The pool is equipped with
Paragon starting platforms and is 8 ft. deep at the start end and 4 ft. deep at the
turn end. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with
104.2.2C(4). A warm up/warm down lane will be available throughout the
competition. PAC will ensure the required course dimensions. Free parking for the
meet is available in the gravel parking lot behind the facility.
Lifeguards will be available during warm-ups and the competition to provide first
aid.

MEET FORMAT This is a single-session Age Group pre-seeded meet.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time. All persons on deck or behind the blocks must be USAS certified coaches, officials, registered swimmers, or meet volunteers.

ELIGIBILITY All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and be members of Piedmont Aquatic Club or invited teams. All Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on deck registration available at this meet

MEMBERS WITH
DISABILITIES ORPiedmont Aquatic Club welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described
in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our
meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any
accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the
Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file,
including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered
service animals. Members who are unable to wear face coverings because of
a documented medical condition must notify the Meet Director in advance
and may have limited deck access. Failure to provide advance notice may
limit Piedmont Aquatic Club's ability to accommodate all requests.

ENTRIES Entries submitted in Hy-Tek format require no hard copy entry forms. E-mail is required for electronic entries. A completed and signed Entry Summary Sheet (included in the announcement) and payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by the entry deadline. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine his/her age for the entire meet. PAC entries will be entered first and then additional teams/entries in the order received, until the four-hour rule is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS Swimmers may enter 3 individual events. Relays will not be conducted.

ENTRY VERIFICATION An email will be sent to the team contacts confirming entry within 48 hours of the receipt.

- **ENTRY DEADLINES** The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by Thursday, September 19, 2024 at 5:00 PM. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director.
- **ENTRY FEES** \$20.00 entry fee per swimmer payable to Piedmont Aquatic Club. Entry fees are non-refundable. There is no facility fee, and the \$20 per swimmer fee includes the \$3/swimmer NCS Travel Fund surcharge.
- **SEEDING** The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order.
- **CHECK-IN** All events will be pre-seeded and there will be no positive check-in.
- **SCRATCHES** There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block.
- **AWARDS** Individual Events Ribbons 1st through 8th place.
- **RESULTS** At the conclusion of the meet, results will be posted on the team website and posted on the NCS website.
- **COACHES** All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request.
- OFFICIALS/
TIMERS/There will be a need for officials. Piedmont Aquatic Club welcomes and
encourages anyone willing to volunteer. Volunteering Officials MUST
contact the Meet Referee by email **prior to the meet.** All officials on deck
must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Certification will be
verified by Meet Referee the day before the meet / session. There will be no
officials meeting at the meet, and assignments will be communicated
electronically prior to each session. A virtual meeting may be held prior to
the meet / session at the referee's discretion, and all assigned officials are
strongly encouraged to complete and individual personal review of
applicable USAS rules for their assigned position prior to the meet. Officials
should report to their assigned position 10 minutes before session start, and
bring a mask, your personal water bottle, and a writing utensil.

HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS

SSIONS There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials. Refreshments will be available at the concession stand.

WARM-UP In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warmup procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). There is

to be no diving or horseplay in this area.

WAIVER/RELEASE As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet. Piedmont Aquatic Club, The Edward M. Armfield Civic and Recreation Center, North Carolina Swimming, Inc., and USA Swimming, Inc., their agents, employees, and coaches shall be held free and harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of illness or injury to anyone during the conduct of this meet. You acknowledge that by entering this meet, you are granting permission for the names of any or all of your team's swimmers to be published on the internet in the form of Psych Sheets, Meet Results, or any other documents associated with the running of this meet.

IMAGE RELEASE All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the host club approved photographer(s) and videographers and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the host club or NCS website or social media or in public broadcast of the event via television or webcast. Parents and guardians of minor swimmers who do not wish their swimmers to participate in interviews or have individual pictures featured on any media should inform their team's head coach and the Meet Director prior to the meet.
