# FACILITY ANDNCAC has discussed specific health and safety procedures with the venue management.HOST TEAMAt this time, the facility and NCAC have no additional requirements. Compliance with<br/>the most current guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, CDC, State<br/>and Local jurisdictions will be maintained throughout the duration of the meet.

FACILITY Koury Natatorium; 400 Skipper Bowles Dr., Chapel Hill, NC, 27514

The pool is an 8-lane, 50-meter pool, which can be divided into two 25-yard course venues, each with non-turbulent lane markers and deck-anchored starting blocks. The Colorado Timing system with touchpads will be used along with buttons and watches in each of 8 nine-foot-wide lanes for competition. Locker rooms for women and men are available. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Prior to each session of competition, the facility host shall examine the bulkhead and shall confirm to the Meet Referee that the bulkhead is stable, straight, and properly positioned and anchored. NCAC will ensure the correct competition course dimensions.

Deck Changing is not allowed during the meet in the facility. Competitors are not permitted access to any areas of the Smith Center (UNC Basketball Arena). Any competitors found trespassing may be removed from the meet. Locker Rooms will be designated for 17U on the pool deck, and a 18O locker room that is in the entry hallway.

Lifeguards will be on the pool deck for medical assistance.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or midthigh regardless of the seam type.

MAAPP All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

**SAFE SPORT** The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming membercoach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member -coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

ELIGIBILITYAll swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. All Adult Athletes must<br/>hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to<br/>entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted.<br/>There will be no on deck registration available at this meet.

#### MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS

NCAC welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants

	required and/or registered service animals. Members who are unable to wear face coverings because of a documented medical condition must notify the Meet Director in advance and may have limited deck access. Failure to provide advance notice may limit NCAC's ability to accommodate all requests.
ENTRIES	<ol> <li>Entries must be submitted via e-mail using Hy-Tek Team Manager, and it is recommended that hard copy Hy-Tek printout be sent as a backup. Electronic entries will take precedence over printed copy in case of discrepancies. Any e- mail entry received will be acknowledged by a confirmation e-mail. If you do not get a confirmation e-mail, your entry has not been processed.</li> <li>Entries must show swimmer's USA ID and actual age of swimmer as of Saturday, October 19th, 2024.</li> <li>Entry fees must be received no later than the first session of the meet. Make checks payable to North Carolina Aquatic Club.</li> <li>Swimmers ages 18 and over must have completed the USA Swimming Athlete Protection Training required by the MAAPP by the time the Meet Recon is complete on Friday October 18th, 2024, otherwise those swimmers could be removed from the meet.</li> <li>A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet.</li> </ol>
ENTRY LIMITATIONS	Swimmers may swim a maximum of six (6) individual events, no more than three (3) per day. Entries will close with the team that puts the total entries over 600 swimmers or stretches the timeline unreasonably. Swimmers can only compete in one session per day.
ENTRY VERIFICATION	An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.
ENTRY DEADLINES	The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by October 9th at 12:00 PM listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Late entries may be accepted on deck at the discretion of the Meet Referee, if empty lanes are available. Fax entries will not be accepted. Express mailing must be sent so as NOT to require a signature. There will be no on deck entries.

SEEDING	The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swim slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order.	
CHECK-IN	400 IM & 500 Freestyle events will require check-in. Check-in will close 45 minutes before the start of the session the event is in.	
SCRATCH RULES	There are no penalties for failing to compete in pre-seeded events. There are no penalties for failing to compete in deck-seeded events.	
SCORING	This meet will not be scored.	
AWARDS	There will be no awards for this meet.	
RESULTS	Results will be posted on the NCAC website within 24 hours of the meets conclusion. At the conclusion of the meet, teams may obtain Hy-Tek meet results files via email attachment.	
COACHES	All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or <u>be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual</u> <u>membership card upon request.</u> There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held	

at the meet referee's discretion.	Meet Management requests that at least one
coach representative from each t	team attend all coaches' meetings.

OFFICIALS/TIMERs/ VOLUNTEERS	There will be a need for officials. <b>NCAC</b> welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer. Volunteering Officials should contact the Meet Referee by email <b>prior to the meet.</b> All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Certification will be verified by Meet Referee the day before the meet/session. There will be a meeting at the day(s)/time(s) listed in the "Deadline and Meeting Summary" above. Meetings may be in-person at the meet or virtual in advance and assignments may be communicated electronically prior to each session. All officials are strongly encouraged to complete an individual personal review of applicable USAS rules prior to the meet. Officials should report at the time specified by the Meet Referee and bring a mask (if necessary) and a writing utensil.
HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS	There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches, officials and volunteers. A concession stand will be open in the seating area.
WARM-UP	In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshal will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.
