The facility and the YBAC Hurricanes have no additional requirements.REQUIREMENTSCompliance with the most current guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming,<br/>CDC, State and Local jurisdictions will be maintained throughout the duration of the meet.

FACILITYOrange County Sportsplex, 101 Meadowlands Drive, Hillsborough, NC 27278.<br/>The Sportsplex pool is a 10-lane, 25-yard course pool with non-turbulent lane markers and<br/>deck-anchored starting blocks. It is 6-feet deep at both the starting and turn ends. An<br/>automatic timing system with touchpads will be used along with buttons and stopwatches in<br/>each of the 10 eight-foot-wide lanes for competition. In addition to the competition pool, the<br/>facility has a warm-up/warm-down pool with 3 lanes for continuous use throughout the meet.<br/>Locker rooms for male and female athletes are available. Use of audio or visual recording<br/>devices, including cell phones, are not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker<br/>rooms. YBAC will ensure the correct competition course dimensions.

Medical support will be provided by facility lifeguards.

Spectators are welcome- bleacher seating is available on the competitive pool side of the facility. Spectators/Parents are not permitted in team seating areas unless they have been approved by the Meet Director.

Deck changes are prohibited at this meet.

This is a timed-final, age-group/senior pre-seeded meet.

ΜΑΑΡΡ	All adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.		
SAFE SPORT	The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race. Deck changes are prohibited. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request an assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend. Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is		

	prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.
ELIGIBILITY	All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. All Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to the entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on-deck registration available at this meet.
MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS	The YBAC Hurricanes welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the YBAC Hurricane's ability to accommodate all requests.
ENTRIES	Entries submitted in Hy-Tek format require no hard copy entry forms and should be emailed to the Meet Director at YBAC@ACYMCA.ORG. A completed and signed Entry Summary Sheet (included in the announcement) and payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by the entry deadline. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. The YBAC Hurricanes entries will be entered first and then accept teams/entries in the order received, until the four/eight- hour rule is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately. <b>'NO TIME'</b> <b>(NT) entries will be accepted at this meet.</b> All relay only swimmers including alternates must be listed and pay the NCS Travel Fund surcharge.
ENTRY LIMITATIONS	Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events plus 1 relay per day; a total of 10 events for the meet. Sessions may be modified to meet the 4-hour rule.
ENTRY VERIFICATION	An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.
ENTRY DEADLINES	The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by Wednesday, November 6, 11:00 PM. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee. There will be no on deck entries.

SEEDING		The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest; with the exception of the 500 Freestyle and 1650 Freestyle, which will be seeded fastest to slowest. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order.			
CHECK-IN		There will be a positive check-in for the 1650 Freestyle. All other events will be pre-seeded.			
SCRATCHES		There will be no penalty for scratching from events at this meet.			
SCORING		There will be no team scoring.			
AWARDS		Ribbons will be awarded to the top 8 finishers in each age group, 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15 & Older. Best new time ribbons will be awarded to 12 & Under swimmers. Most Improved Award will be presented to the swimmer scoring the most points based on the Hy-Tek Improvement Scoring System. Ties will be broken with the total time dropped.			
RESULTS		Results will be available within 24 hours of the meet's conclusion.			
COACHES		All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.			
OFFICIALS/TII	MERS/VOLUNTEERS	There will be a need for officials. The YBAC Hurricanes welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer. Volunteering Officials should contact the Meet Referee by email <b>prior to the meet.</b> All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Certification will be verified by Meet Referee the day before the meet/session. There will be a meeting at the day(s)/time(s) listed in the "Deadline and Meeting Summary" above. Meetings may be in-person at the meet or virtual in advance and assignments may be communicated electronically prior to each session. All officials are strongly encouraged to complete an individual personal review of applicable			

	USAS rules prior to the meet. Officials should report at the time specified by the Meet Referee and bring a mask (if necessary) and a writing utensil.
HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS	There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials. Refreshments and snacks will also be available at the concession stand.
WARM-UP	In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm- up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshal will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). <b>There is to be no diving or</b> <b>horseplay in this area.</b>
