- LOCAL It is the responsibility of GCY and swimmers' parents to screen athletes for PROTOCOLS potential exposure to COVID-19 during the week prior to the meet. By entering this meet, swimmers, as well as their coaches and families, agree that they will not attend the meet (including as spectator) if any of the following are true: the athlete or person who resides in the home of the athlete tests positive for COVID-19, is awaiting results from a COVID-19 test, exhibits symptoms of COVID-19, believes he/she has COVID-19, has travelled to a COVID-19 "hotspot" in the prior two weeks, has travelled internationally in the prior two weeks, or has come into close contact with someone with COVID-19. Symptoms of COVID-19 include: fever within the past three (3) days; runny nose, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; chills; diarrhea; vomiting; nausea; headache; loss of taste and/or smell; other flulike symptoms. Temperature checks will be performed by GCY on all coaches, officials, and volunteers before they are allowed on deck.

There will be one timer per lane with one head timer.

Shared items such as watches, clipboards, writing utensils, starting equipment, etc., will be sanitized before and after each session by GCY. The facility staff will also be sanitizing the pool deck and any other high touch areas between sessions.

To enter the pool deck there will be a designated entrance and exit. This will be a one-way loop. The entrance to the pool deck will be through the locker room for athletes and through the hospitality room for volunteers. The exit will be through the hallway to the training pool.

The total facility capacity allowed under COVID-19 regulations is 264.

The following personnel will be allowed in the facility per session: 3 coaches 1 meet director 4 marshals (taking temperatures, pool deck staging, locker rooms, etc.) 1 volunteer co-ordinator 12 facility personnel 7 officials (1 referee, 1 starter, 4 stroke & turn judges, 1 administrative official) 60 athletes 9 timers

<u>Warm-Ups</u>

All warm ups must be supervised by team coaches or designated team volunteers to assure safe distancing layout with a maximum of 3 swimmers per lane and to ensure 6' social distancing during sprints.

Warm up/down lanes will be available during each session and will be monitored by meet marshals.

LOCKER ROOMS/ CHANGING Athletes must arrive and depart in their suits. Deck changing is prohibited. Locker rooms will be limited to restroom use only and must not be used for changing or showering. The locker rooms will be monitored by marshals. Marshals will remind athletes to social distance at all times. All athletes must use on-deck showers to rinse prior to entering the pool.

ENTRY & EXIT
PROCEDURESAll athletes, coaches and volunteers will enter and exit the facility through the
box office doors. When entering the facility, all athletes and coaches will enter
and proceed to their designated seating area. Designated seating area will be
in the grandstand with social distancing markings on the seats. No outside
chairs are allowed in the facility. Volunteers should check in with the volunteer
coordinator and proceed to the appropriately assigned area.

SWIMMER LIMITATIONS and PROTOCOLS

The total number of athletes allowed is 60 per session.

There will be heat staging around the pool deck leading to the starting blocks. Swimmers should be in the staging area no more than 10 minutes prior to their races.

Athletes will follow signage around the pool deck from seating area to pool entry/exit.

Athletes will place their personal items in a lane basket behind the designated lane. Athlete masks should be placed in a plastic bag identified with their name. Plastic bags are the responsibility of GCY.

After each race athletes will exit the pool, replace their masks and continue to their coaches for feedback.

Swimmers will be allowed in the building no more than fifteen (15) minutes prior to their warm up times and must leave the building immediately after their last swim of the session.

When not in the water, athletes are expected to wear a mask at all times, including when walking to and from an event and/or warm-up lanes. They may remove masks for swimming but must replace them again once they exit the water. Additionally, athletes are expected to maintain proper distancing at all times.

There will be no spectators allowed at this event.

HEALTHIngress to the facility requires health screening questions and/or a**SCREENING**temperature check before entering in accordance with CDC and local health
department recommendation.

Swimmers, coaches and volunteers must be screened by the team prior to entering. The Greensboro Aquatic Center staff will be temperature checked upon entry into the building daily.

FACILITY The Greensboro Aquatic Center is a state-of-the-art indoor facility with four pools. The main competition pool is 9-10 feet deep at both ends and can be configured into two 25-yard courses with up to ten 7-foot wide lanes each. All lanes feature non-turbulent lane lines and KDI Paragon starting blocks. Up to ten lanes will be used for this competition. The Omega electronic timing system will be used. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

MEET FORMAT This is a timed final Age Group/Senior, pre-seeded meet.

SAFE SPORT The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to GCY marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet who is unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

ELIGIBILITY All swimmers must be registered with North Carolina Swimming and USA Swimming, Inc. and be members of the Greensboro Community YMCA Swim Team. All Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. **There will be no on deck registration available at this meet.**

MEMBERS WITH
DISABILITIES OR
MEDICALGCY welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA
Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets.
Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any
accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the
Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file,
including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered
service animals. Members who are unable to wear face coverings because
of a documented medical condition must notify the Meet Director in
advance and may have limited deck access. Failure to provide advance
notice may limit GCY's ability to accommodate all requests.

ENTRIES Entries submitted in Hy-tek format require no hard copy entry forms. Email is preferred for electronic entries however; disks are also acceptable. A completed and signed Entry Summary Sheet (included in the announcement) and payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by the entry deadline. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. GCY entries will be entered first and then accept teams/entries in the order received, until 1¹/₂ hour session is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately.

- ENTRY Swimmers in session 1 may swim a maximum of 3 individual events; swimmers in session 2 may swim a maximum of 4 individual events. LIMITATIONS
- An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt ENTRY VERIFICATION of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

Officials should report to their assigned position 10 minutes before session start, and bring a mask, a personal water bottle and a writing utensil. There will be no hospitality available.
WARM-UP	In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. At any time during the meet there should be no more than 3 swimmers per lane. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.
