EAST CAROLINA AQUATICS COVID-19 MEET PLAN

- **FACE COVERINGS** All meet participants coaches, officials, administrators, spectators, vendors, and athletes (between events) must wear face coverings and comply with mandated social distancing and mass gathering rules.
- Total facility capacity is 254 occupants and 200 spectators, however, ECA will be limiting the total number of combined swimmers, volunteers, and coaches to 71.

 - Capacity numbers will be tracked by the MEET MARSHAL
 - Number of timers 1 TIMER PER LANE Timers will utilize a stopwatch and plunger
 - Restroom facilities in the SC lobby (main building) are for parents and coaches only. Locker room restrooms on pool deck are for swimmers only and cannot be used for changing or showering. No more than 3 swimmers in the restroom at a time.
 - ALL Timer papers, stopwatches, and pencils will be sanitized after each session by a volunteer designee.

Warm-Ups

- Swimmers are encouraged to bring their own chair to place in their individual seating area.
- Swimmers will be escorted to warm-up by the coaching staff. Proper socially distancing will be maintained and masks will be worn until swimmers are completely ready to enter the water.
- A MAXIMUM OF THREE (3) SWIMMERS PER LANE FOR ALL WARMUPS AND WARMDOWNS - SWIMMERS WILL BE SPACED AT 1 PER LANE AT EACH END AND 1 SWIMMER STARTING FROM THE MIDDLE PER LANE.
- Meet director will monitor the pool to ensure proper lane limitations are followed.
- In-water max capacity: 33 athletes
- The total capacity in the facility, including swimmers, volunteers, staff, and coaches will be limited to 71.

LOCKER ROOMS/Athletes must arrive and depart in their suits. Locker rooms are for restroom use onlyCHANGINGand must not be used for changing or showering. Deck changing is prohibited.
Restrooms will be monitored by the MEET MARSHAL

ENTRY & EXIT All meet participants – coaches, officials, meet volunteers, and athletes **PROCEDURES** and (between events) must wear face coverings and comply with mandated social ATHLETE SEATING distancing and mass gathering rules. AREAS • There will be NO SPECTATORS allowed inside the gate of the facility. • No vendors will be present at the meet All participants for each session will enter the complex through the front gate -0 main entrance and proceed to a predetermined seating area spaced 8 feet apart multi-directionally from one another on the pavilion side of the pool. Participants are encouraged to bring their own chairs for use in their assigned 0 area. Once an athlete has finished their last event, they are asked to exit the facility 0 immediately through the back gate. There will be a designated pick-up are for those athletes. SWIMMER **Total number of athletes allowed per** session – 33 athletes per session LIMITATIONS and Swimmers will be escorted from designated seating area to the starting blocks PROTOCOLS by heat by a designated meet volunteer. Swimmers should wait for meet volunteer to announce the heat before moving • toward the block. Swimmers will walk 8 feet apart in a single file while being escorted to the blocks before the race. Swimmers need to be ready to race once they have reached the starting block - goggles, towel, cap, etc. Swimmers will place their masks on the towels while racing. After completion of the race, swimmers will be escorted to the warmup/warm-down area exercising proper social distancing both on the walk and in the water. A designated coaches' area will be available for race analysis after the conclusion of each race. Swimmers and coaches will maintain proper social distancing and properly wear a mask during these interactions. Athletes should arrive 15 minutes before the start of their specified warm-up session and leave immediately after the conclusion of their final race. When not in the water, athletes are expected to wear a mask at all times, including when walking to and from an event and/or warm-up lanes. They may remove masks for swimming but must don them again once they exit the water. Additionally, athletes are expected to maintain proper distancing at all times. SPECTATOR There will be no "In-Person" spectator viewing. The meet will be live-streamed via LIMITATIONS and FACEBOOK LIVE PROTOCOLS Spectators/Parents are required to wear a face covering at all times while attending, observing or meeting with their athletes at the meet whether inside the facility, in any adjacent viewing/gathering areas provided by the EAST CAROLINA AQUATICS, or meeting with their swimmer in a designated facility location and are expected to comply with all mandated state/local/facility COVID-19 guidelines.

In addition to waivers, all entrants will be subject to a temperature check by a meet marshal and designated volunteer. No one with a temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher will be allowed in the facility. Those who do not want to be subject to a temperature check will be barred from the facility as well.
