NCS FACE COVERINGFollowing new CDC recommendations and the North Carolina Governor's latest Executive OrderSTATEMENTissued May 14, 2021, North Carolina Swimming has revised guidance on the use of face coverings
at USA Swimming activities as follows:

- North Carolina Swimming strongly recommends that partially vaccinated or unvaccinated individuals continue to wear face coverings and practice social distancing at all swimming activities.
- Other individuals are welcome to continue wearing face coverings for personal comfort.
- NCS clubs may require that participants wear face coverings and observe social distancing at meets that they host.
- NCS members are expected to comply with all COVID-19 safety guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, the State of North Carolina, local jurisdictions, aquatic facilities, and member clubs.
- FACILITY and BACBAC has discussed specific health and safety procedures with the venue management. At thisREQUIREMENTSEaclity and BAC have no additional requirements. Compliance with the most current
guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, CDC, State and Local jurisdictions will
be maintained throughout the duration of the meet.

SPECTATORThere will be no "In-Person" spectator viewing. BAC will live-stream the meet via the BACLIMITATIONS andGators Facebook page. Parents will have access to the hall restrooms outside of the pool.PROTOCOLS

- **PARENTAL ACCESS** Parents needing access to their athlete during the meet in a closed-deck environment can contact their children directly via cellphone and arrange to meet them outside the doors to the therapy pool. Should parents be unable to contact their child directly, they should see the Meet Marshall at the entrance. In the case of an emergency, please call and/or text Julie Long at 610-316-9448.
- FACILITYThe competition pool is an 8-lane 25-yard pool with non-turbulent lane lines (7 ft. width),
Colorado electric timing with touch pads, backup plungers and fixed starting blocks. Two
timers per lane; one operating a watch and plunger button and one operating a watch only.
There is an additional 20- yard warm water pool for continuous warm up and warm down.
Pool depth 6 1/2 feet at start end and 5 feet at turn end. The competition course has not
been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
- **MEET FORMAT** This is a timed final, pre-seeded meet.

RULES	This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional, and exceptions are stated. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, changing rooms or behind starting blocks. Deck changes are prohibited.
TECHNICAL SUIT BAN for 12&Us	Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.
	 A Technical Suit is one that has the following components: Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.
МААРР	All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
SAFE SPORT	The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to BAC's marshal.
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.
	Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming membercoach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member -coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

ELIGIBILITYAll swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and be members of BAC
or NSEA. All Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete.
Swimmers must be registered prior to the entry deadline. Entries listed as
"Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on deck
registration available at this meet.

MEMBERS WITHBAC welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA SwimmingDISABILITIES ORRules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches enteringMEDICAL CONDITIONSswimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to
provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline
accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants
required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may
limit BAC's ability to accommodate all requests.

- ENTRIES Entries submitted in Hy-Tek format require no hard copy entry forms. Email is preferred for electronic entries however; disks are also acceptable. A completed and signed Entry Summary Sheet (included in the announcement) and payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by the start of the meet. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. BAC entries will be entered first and then accept teams/entries in the order received, until the four/eight-hour rule is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately. All relay-only swimmers including alternates must be listed and pay the NCS Travel Fund surcharge.
- **ENTRY LIMITATIONS** Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events and 1 relay event each session. Teams may enter a maximum of 3 relay teams per relay event.

ENTRY VERIFICATION An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

ENTRY DEADLINES The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. No late entries will be accepted. There will be no on deck entries.

SEEDING	The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non- conforming times will be seeded last in rank order
CHECK-IN	All events will be pre-seeded and there will be no positive check-in.
SCRATCHES	There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block.
SCORING	The Meet will be scored in the following manner Individual events: 12-9-6-3-2-1 Relay events: 24-12-6
AWARDS	No awards will be given.
RESULTS	Results will be posted on BAC's website within 24 hours of the meet's conclusion. At the conclusion of the meet, teams may obtain Hy-Tek backups either on a memory stick or via email attachment.
COACHES	All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.
OFFICIALS/TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS	There will be a need for officials. BAC welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer. Volunteering Officials should contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Certification will be verified by the Meet Referee the day before the meet/session. There will be a meeting at the day(s)/time(s) listed in the "Deadline and Meeting Summary" above. Meetings may be in-person at the meet or virtual in advance and assignments may be communicated electronically prior to each session. All officials are strongly encouraged to complete an individual personal review of applicable USAS rules prior to the meet. Officials should report at the time specified by the Meet Referee and bring a mask (if necessary) and a writing utensil.
HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS	There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials. Refreshments will be available in the hospitality area and distributed on deck.
WARM-UP	In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for short term warm-up/down. There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.
