Parking: Parking in the lot outside of the pool building or on Morrill Dr. is

by NSCU permit only until 5:00pm. Prior to 5:00pm, hourly parking is available in the parking garage on Cates Dr. (Exit the pool parking lot, turn left on Morrill Dr, turn right on Cates, the parking garage is one block down on the left.) After 5:00pm the lot

and parking spots on Morrill Dr. are open.

Facility: The competition pool at NC State is an 8-lane, 25-yard pool. The

depth of the pool is 4 feet deep in Lane 1 and gradually gets deeper from Lane 1 to Lane 8 (diving well is outside of Lane 8 where the

depth is 12 feet). The lanes are 78" wide.

The 50-meter pool will be set up for short course swimming in 12 lanes and will be available throughout warm up time and the duration of the meet for warm up and cool down swimming.

The blocks are KDI Paragon blocks.

A Colorado 6 Timing System will be used along with watches in each of the 8 lanes for competition. An 8-lane digital scoreboard is

on site and will be used as well.

Spectator seating for approximately 1000 people is available, as well as ADA accessible viewing. Men's and Women's locker room facilities are available, as well as separate restrooms for spectators.

possible pending final number of teams participating.

Entries: Submit entries on Team Manager by emailing them to Meet

Management. List the swimmers age as of December 18, 2009. Per NCS rules, a roster of swimmers entered in the meet will be sent to NC Swimming for verification of USA Swimming registration.

All swimmers in the meet must be NCS or USA registered.

Submit entries to: Meet entries will be accepted via email prior to 12:00pm on the

Scoring: All events will be scored as relay events and points are awarded

according to USA Swimming rules.

Warm-up: Warm-up will begin at 4:00pm. Warm up lane assignments will be

determined and posted around the pool.

Time Schedule: The meet director reserves the right to change warm-up and start

times based on the time line. Any changes to the meet schedule

will be announced prior to the start of the meet.

Safety: The NC Swimming Safety Program is in effect for this meet.

Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all

times. No running or horseplay will be tolerated.
