

Our story starts on August 20th, 1966, our wedding day. Mick and I were two young people who didn't really know what we wanted to be when we grew up or what was possible. We've had our share of designing, developing, and delivering ideas together since the day we married and we've traveled very far from our roots in a small backyard pool teaching local kids to swim.

In 1972 Illinois Swimming gave us an opportunity to attend and work at the Olympic Trials in Portage Park, Illinois. What I remember most about that experience is that Mick and I were inspired to start thinking how we could give children in our hometown the opportunity to maybe one day compete in the Olympic Trials. By the last day of the trials the excitement of watching swimmers perform and famous swim coaches guide them had our minds racing and had us motived.

As it turned out, we were in transition as a couple. Not entirely happy with work prospects and uncertain how we could set goals for our family and engage in meaningful work, we were open to just about anything that might allow us to be with our children and not miss any milestones because of being away at work. It occurred to us that we maybe wanted to be something else other than just a nine to five employees. It occurred to us that maybe we wanted to be parents as much as we wanted to be creatively involved in the lives of other people.

Looking back most of our big decisions were forced by the hand of necessity as well as our desire for making our own opportunities. After the 1972 Olympic Trials were over and we were heading back home, we stopped at a restaurant and ended up deep in conversation about how could we build a pool, teach swimming, and grow our current swim team. A goal was born and it felt possible.

We were already teaching swimming from a small 20' x 40' pool in Mick's parent's backyard. Early on we knew we had to sell our idea and our vision if we were going to make it out of the dreaming phase and into the design phase. We garnered the support of Mick's mother as business partner. We drafted a business plan that included not just teaching swimming lessons but also building a swimming team. During the dream phase of our planning, we started gathering information and getting advice from other businesspeople. We faced endless skepticism and we heard the word "no" a great deal, but eventually with a clear vision we had the support we needed. We've been designing, developing, and delivering ever since. The story is ongoing Stay tuned for what we really want to be when we grow up!
